

"I don't have time to read the Bible."

Uh-oh, I've let this lie rob me of spending time with the Savior before. Yuck. I don't want to choose chatting, learning, cooking, playing, working, or cell-staring (beware of made up words) over spending time with God. If you know what I mean by cell-staring then, like me, you've probably had your eyes glued to your cell-phone at one time or another when you could have been doing a jillion more productive things. It happens. The thing is God doesn't say we can't learn, work, chat, or play. But, ultimately He should be most important in our lives. If He's most important in our lives, I'm thinking we'll want to spend time with Him, and in His Word. Let's think of His Word as a gift to us. We get to read this amazing collection of writings from the the Creator of the Universe. So, let's read them. Soak them in. Listen to them. And, most importantly let's love Him.

O.K. so as you dive into this devotional guide be prepared to enjoy the Word of God. Be prepared to dig deeper, ask questions, and find answers. Be prepared to worship God. When you use the prayer journal portion called *Enter In* simply list your praise and prayer requests using keywords, you know, kind of like hashtags that give the main idea. Why? because the goal of *Enter In* is primarily to pray! So #pray. Talk to God. Acknowledge His greatness. Refresh your soul. For those of you writers out there who think keyword prayer journals are horrible, don't worry. The *Free Write* section will come to your rescue. It's open for all writing throughout your devotion time.

Another thing. If you're sipping tea, having a bit of cake (chocolate of course) and loving your time in the Word, but then choke on the cake because you're asked to jot down facts from Bible history, key facts about a person mentioned in the verse, or Greek and Hebrew definitions, relax. It's going to be OK. Take care of the cake issue. Then use your staring device—your cell-phone or computer—to look up [blueletterbible.org](http://blueletterbible.org). It's packed full of study and devotional materials.

On the home page of [blueletterbible.org](http://blueletterbible.org) you'll immediately see a place to look up verses. If you're anything like me, you'll get all clicky from there as you discover various tools including, an interlinear Bible, commentaries, dictionaries, cross-references and more. You can also start at the home page and click on *study* at the top, then click on *Encyclopedias/Dictionaries* if you want to look up info about a certain topic or a special someone. For example, if you want to know more about Paul click on "P" and scroll your way down to find his name. Yay! What a great resource, right!? So, just remember whatever resources you choose to use to supplement your devotional time compare everything you read with the Word of God. Make sure you're taking in truth based on His Word.

Oh, this is fun! You're going to be amazed by God and His Word. Keep reading and praying on the hard days. God will keep speaking through His Word on those days as well. And, lovely, as lovely can be—He won't ever leave you. He'll always love you!

OK. I'll stop now. My words are not important compared to the words you're about to read!

P.S. Each day is started with the *Enter In* journal page. I want to encourage you to end each day with prayer as well. Talk to God. Thank Him for His Word, His guidance, and His love. O.K. I'm seriously gonna let God's Word do the talking now, my daily instructions and input will be brief.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Today praise God for His holiness and thank Him for His Word. Spend time in prayer. Ask Him to speak to you as you study His Word.

**ON TOPIC:**

Turn to your *On Topic* journal page and at the top, in the section labeled *Topic*, record your topic. Topic --> "God's Word"

**BIBLE:**

Read 2 Timothy 3 in your Bible.

**ON TOPIC:**

Find 2 verses in 2 Timothy 3 that refer to Scripture/God's Word. Record them on the *On Topic* journal page you just labeled.

In the *Notes* section next to each verse write your thoughts. Either summarize the verse in your own words or share how the verse applies to you personally.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Today praise God for His creation and thank Him for people He's put in your life. Spend time in prayer. Ask Him to speak to you as you study His Word.

**FREE WRITE:**

Familiarize yourself with questions 1-5 listed at the bottom of day two under the heading *Questions*.

**BIBLE:**

Read 2 Timothy 3:15-17

**FREE WRITE:**

Answer Questions 1-5 on your *Free Write* journal page. Base your answers on 2 Timothy 3:15-17. Restate the main point of the question, and the scripture reference, in your answers.

**QUESTIONS:**

1. According to verse 15 what are the "sacred writings" able to do?
2. Who is Scripture breathed out by?
3. What is Scripture profitable for?
4. According to verse 17, what can the "man of God" be as a result of Scripture's role in their life?

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Today praise God for sending His Son and thank Him for a specific blessing. Spend time in prayer. Ask Him to speak to you as you study His Word.

**TREASURE:**

Add 2 Timothy 3:16-17 to your *Treasure*. Write the verses as a whole first. Then split them up into sections that make sense to you.

Sketch a quick something that will help you remember what each section says.

Read through the verse written in *Split Sections* 3 times while looking at your sketches.

Cover the verse text and try to say the verse while only looking at the sketches.

Try to say as much of the verse as possible without looking. Remember to include the reference.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Today praise God for His unending love and thank Him for a specific blessing. Spend time in prayer. Ask Him to speak to you as you study His Word.

**STORYBOARD:**

Journal the following four verses in *Storyboard*.

Remember to make up your own title, caption, and illustration to help you remember what you read about God and His words.

Verses to storyboard: Proverbs 30:5, Proverbs 30:6, Proverbs 2:6 Psalm 18:30. Each verse gets it's own *Storyboard* box.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Today praise God for His character and thank Him for a specific blessing. Spend time in prayer. Ask Him to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119.

**ENTER IN:**

Spend time in prayer again. Ask God to continue to speak to you through Psalm 119 over the next few days.

**ENTER IN:**

From today forward you choose what to praise God for. List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**STORYBOARD:**

Remember to make up your own title, caption, and illustration to help you remember what you read about God and His words.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Listen to Psalm 119:1-88 on Bible.is

**LIVE IT:**

Choose 2 verses (they don't have to be consecutive) from Psalm 119 to record in the *Live It* portion of your journal. Find verses, with action words, that remind you of an action God wants you to take.

Example: In Psalm 119:9 you could choose the action word "keep" or the word "guarding."

Fill out one *Live It* section for each verse by following the instructions on the *Live It* journal page.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Listen to Psalm 119:89-176 on Bible.is

**LIVE IT:**

Choose 2 more verses from Psalm 119 to record in the *Live It* portion of your journal. Fill out one *Live It* section for each verse by following the instructions on the *Live It* journal page.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119:9-10

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Complete the *Select a Verse* section by writing the date, recording Psalm 119 as the section read, and recording Psalm 119:9-10 as the verse you will *apply ARCHES* to.

**STORYBOARD:**

Turn back to the eight storyboards you've completed in this study so far. Review the passages they're based on.

Share your storyboards with a friend or family member. In your own words tell them the story behind each illustration.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Listen to Psalm 119 on Bible.is

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Back to the *Doorway to Discovery* you started yesterday. Using Psalm 119:9-10 complete the section labeled *Application*. It's only two questions. Be careful not to complete the section under the word *STOP*.

You can also use cross-references to discover more facts about the person/people mentioned in the verse you are studying.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119:41-88

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Using Psalm 119:9-10 complete the section labeled *Connections: Context Connections*. (Don't complete *Cross-Reference Connections* just yet.)

For more instruction see the *Doorway to Discovery, How-To Guide*.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119:89-112

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Using Psalm 119:9-10 complete the section labeled *Connections: Cross-Reference Connections*.

For more instruction see the *Doorway to Discovery, How-To Guide*.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119:113-152

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Please skip the *History* section of *Doorway to Discovery*. Not all the sections need to be used every time you study.

Using Psalm 119:9-10 complete the first two sections listed under *Exact Words*. We don't want to forget the exact words we are studying, right?!

For more instruction see the *Doorway to Discovery, How-To Guide*. [Blueletterbible.org](http://Blueletterbible.org) will come in handy for this section also.

**ENTER IN:**

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

**BIBLE:**

Read Psalm 119:153-176

**DOORWAY TO DISCOVERY:**

Using Psalm 119:9-10 complete the last section under *Exact Words* and the section labeled *Savior*. The second question gives you an opportunity to reflect on your previous sections and consider what you've learned about God.

### STORYBOARD:

Storyboard Ephesians 6:10-18 verse by verse in order to see the overall picture Paul paints for us in that part of chapter 6.

Sketches can be elaborate or simple, include stick figures, detailed sketches, word art, or icons to represent the content in each verse.

Start by storyboarding Ephesians 6:10 in the first rectangle, storyboard Ephesians 6:11 in the second rectangle and so on. Continue until you finish verses 10-18. Be sure to include a title, a verse reference, and a caption for each verse.

### ENTER IN:

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

### ON TOPIC:

Record Ephesians 6:17 on your *On Topic* page. In the notes section next to the verse comment on how you believe you should use the sword.

### BIBLE:

Read Hebrews 4:12

### FREE WRITE:

Answer the questions listed below on your *Free Write* journal pages. Restate each question in your answer.

### QUESTIONS:

1. According to Hebrews 4:12, what are five things the word of God is?
2. What does this description of God's word make you think God's written Word, the Bible, has the power to do in your life?

### ENTER IN:

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

### BIBLE:

Let's take a look at what 1 Kings says about God's commandments, statutes, rules, and words. Read the story of Solomon's temple dedication in 1 Kings 8:54-61 (Optional: read 1 Kings chapters 6-8 for a more complete look at the story).

### FREE WRITE:

Answer the two questions listed below on your *Free Write* page.

### QUESTIONS:

1. According to 1 Kings 8:56 what did the LORD give to his people? 2. What did not fail?

### LIVE IT:

Record 1 Kings 8:58 on your *Live It* journal page. In the notes section next to it jot down one action this verse encourages the people of Israel to do. *Hint:* 1 John 2:3 and 1 John 5:2-3 also show us this particular action is important.

### ENTER IN:

List praise and prayer requests. Spend time in prayer. Ask God to speak to you as you study His Word.

### BIBLE:

Read 1 Kings 8:54-61 again.

### ON TOPIC:

Record 1 Kings 8:61 on your *On Topic* journal page (just use the next space available). In the notes section write what you think this verse means, or how it applies to you personally, or what a trusted commentary/pastor says regarding it.
